Blessing in Disguise has had a request for a specialist wheel chair for 12 year old terminally ill Eve, who suffers with Leighs Encephalopathy, Cerebral Palsy, Epilepsy Kypho Scoliosis and is Tracheostomy ventilated. Eve needs the a specialised "Chunc" wheelchair because her shape changes frequently (due to her Scoliosis) her current moulded chair is not adjustable and unsuitable. Eves spinal curvature makes standard seating difficult to maintain.
